Jinks, Catherine. <u>The reformed vampire support group</u>. 2009. Nina really should be sixty-six, but instead she's been stuck as a fifteen-year-old vampire for the past half-century. YA JIN

McBride, Lish. <u>Hold Me Closer, Necromancer</u>. 2010. Sam LaCroix's life is stuck in neutral, working at a fast food restaurant – and what is that huge crow doing *LOOKING AT HIM* like that?
