Q. Where do I vote?

A. You vote in the Library on Tuesday, April 9 from 9:30am to 9:00pm.

Q. Who is eligible to vote?

A. All residents of the CSH School District who are registered to vote in the school district's annual budget vote are eligible to vote in the CSH Library election. Call Election Clerk, Suzette Vano, at (631) 692-6820, x501 for details.

Q. I will be away on April 9. Can I get an absentee ballot?

A. Yes, if you are unable to vote in person, you may apply for an absentee ballot. Applications will be available at the Circulation Desk and on the Library's website after March 1.



Dear Residents,

The staff and Trustees of the Cold Spring Harbor Library strive to offer quality resources that enhance the lives of everyone in the community.

On Tuesday, April 9, we will be holding our annual Budget Vote and Trustee Election at the Library. The proposed budget for the 2024-2025 fiscal year has a 2.6% tax levy increase, which is under the New York State tax levy limit.

During the 2022-2023 fiscal year, over 58,000 patrons used the library, a 29% increase from the previous fiscal year, as we continue to bounce back from the pandemic. Over 10,500 people participated in our programs, and over 35,000 eBooks and 36,000 books and other materials were borrowed. The library offers programs and resources for all ages, and we are very pleased that the community is taking advantage of these services.
