A ghost tries to take the kids that come into the graveyard. I like that this book is scary. It's well written with a lot of details about the ghost and the setting.



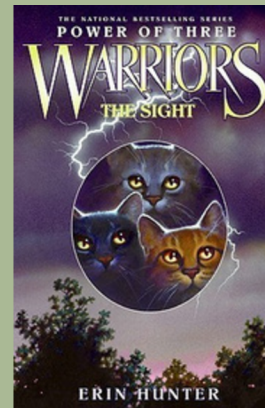

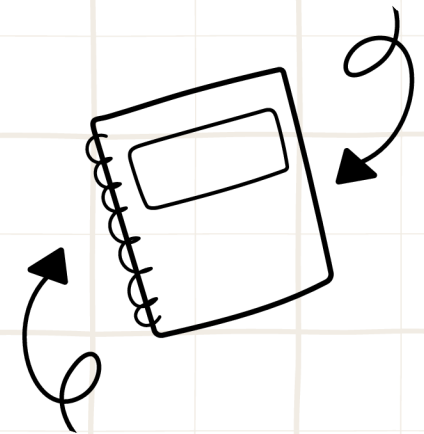

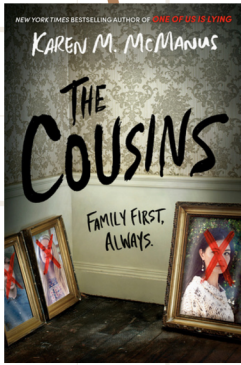
