**Q.** I will be away on April 11. Can I get an absentee ballot?

**A.** Yes, if you are unable to vote in person, you may apply for an absentee ballot. Applications will be available at the Circulation Desk and on the Library's website after March 1.



Dear Residents,

The staff and Trustees of the Cold Spring Harbor Library strive to offer quality resources that enhance the lives of everyone in the community.

On Tuesday, April 11, we will be holding our annual Budget Vote and Trustee Election at the Library. The proposed budget for the 2023-2024 fiscal year has a 2.6% tax levy increase, which is under the New York State tax levy limit.

During the 2021-2022 fiscal year, 45,000 patrons used the Library, including 10,000 who participated in our programs. 34,000 eBooks and 40,000 books and other materials were borrowed. The Library offers programs and resources for all ages, and we are very pleased that the community is taking advantage of these services.
