General Teen Community Service Programs (1 –2 hours)

Check our online calendar for upcoming monthly service programs. Some are online, others in person. Register on our website!

Book Buddies program—(1.5 hours)

Read picture and storybooks to young children, typically fitting a seasonal theme. Volunteers will be paired with a young reader (Grades K-5) who will be a Book Buddy. Program provides 1.5 hours of community service credit and usually run bimonthly.

Teen Library Council (1 hour)

Join our monthly meeting and provide input on programs & services for teens.

Citizen Science with iNaturalist (1 hour per 10 observations)

Use the iNaturalist app to log photos of wildlife and plants in your area. Select a suggested ID for the organism and let the community peer review it as a contribution to science! Email a photo of your log to teen@cshlibrary.org for credit. Every 10 observations (including an ID attempt) counts for 1 hour of service.

Teen Nature Club Series(1- 2 hours)

Each month the library holds at least one Teen Nature Club relevant to learning about the ecosystem, contributing to Citizen Science and wildlife.

Teen Teach Video or Class—(Variable Hours)

Show us your skills with a video tutorial! Cook, craft, game, or even make a tutorial for our digital services to be posted on our website and social media. Alternatively, run a program in person for your peers or Children. **Please contact teen@cshlibrary.org to submit a program idea and for our full guidelines on making videos.**
